

World Water Forum

It is the world's largest water-related event organized every three years. The 7th World Water Forum set its core value as **Implementation** to concretize solutions to water challenges that have been discussed throughout the previous Fora.



Organizational Chart



- **The World Water Council:** It is an international organization whose mission is to raise awareness on critical water issues, to generate decisions and actions and to create political commitment for a world in which water is available to all in sufficient quantity and quality.
- **The National Committee:** It sets basic directions for forum operation at the national level.
- **The International Steering Committee:** ISC serves as the ultimate decision-making body of the 7th World Water Forum. It is composed of NC and WWC members.




